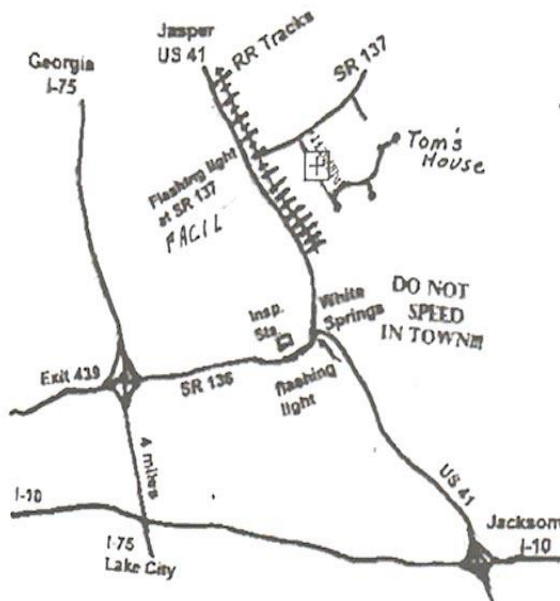

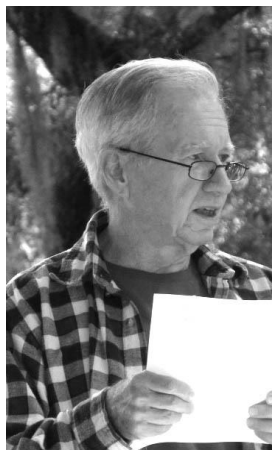

Minutes of the January 11, 2025 meeting at Wilderness Shores Ranch/Campground in Lakeland are as follows:

Lew noted that he couldn't understand how Freeze for All could only charge \$25 per night for the event. A closer reading of the flier indicated that the event costs \$25 per night for camping, PLUS a \$50 fee for the event. Nobody at the meeting could ever remember a vanning event where the cost for camping and cost for the event were separate items.

Judith noted that someone got stupid at a recent event she attended and there was nothing but confusion in trying to get medical help for the person. Nobody seemed to have an emergency contact number, or any way to find out the name and contact information for the person who would be in charge, in case of a medical emergency. She noted that it would be a really good idea to add a section on all our fliers for an emergency name and contact information for the person to be contacted in case of an emergency. She also put this item to be added to the agenda of the next CofC meeting when she filled out the FVC council registration form for that meeting.

Cari made a motion to adjourn and the 28-minute meeting was concluded at 1:01 PM

FLORIDA VAN COUNCIL - THE HISTORY

The Florida Van Council was organized in September of 1974 to promote the van club movement and statewide truck-ins. One year later, having grown in size from the original five clubs, to 21 member clubs, it became necessary to restructure the organization and, on October 11, 1975, the FVC was re-organized to:

1. Provide co-ordination and sanctioning of statewide events held by the member clubs.
2. Provide statewide communication to all member clubs at and during the intervals between regular scheduled meetings.

It was necessary for the FVC to coordinate events so that no two clubs would schedule a statewide event for the same month, which would result in poor attendance and a possible reduction in the enjoyment for both events. Coordination helped further by limiting statewide sanctioned events to six per year so that Florida vanners didn't get "trucked-out" as they did during the first year of the FVC existence when statewide truck-ins were held every month. "Sanctioned" means the FVC will be sure the member club has selected a site with adequate facilities and will provide assistance in the way of advice to the member club regarding activities, security, gate, check-in, etc. It was decided that this would give each club a free hand in deciding on site locations, activities, van judging (if van judging is part of the event, then the FVC judging rules will be used), etc., but would ensure that minimum facilities would be available for everyone to have a good time, and the host club will have all the FVC knowledge and advice behind it so that previous mistakes are not repeated.

Statewide communication was accomplished at the regular business meetings, by letters from the FVC officers to the Club Reps, and distribution of the FVC Newsletter to each FVC member. At the

time the newsletter was first issued in February of 1976 the council had grown in size to 38 clubs. At the end of 1979 the member clubs numbered 68. Council meetings are held 5 times a year. The meetings are held at campgrounds and most people stay over at least one night. We have found that this is a good way to get to know each other and a great way to exchange ideas.

Active contact was made with other states, regional van councils and other van organizations in 1977, which led to an annual meeting of the Southeastern regional van councils, (FVC, Southern Van Council, Georgia Van Council, North Carolina/South Carolina Van Council) to help coordinate regional events. This Council meeting has turned into a meeting of councils from all over the country with the meetings held in February of each year. This meeting is now called "The Council Of Councils Meeting".

Since its inception the FVC has been on the move, with a continual goal of improvement and better service to its members.
