side of flier

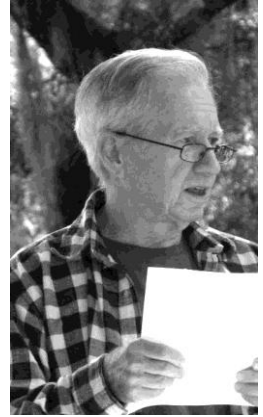
FLORIDA VAN COUNCIL

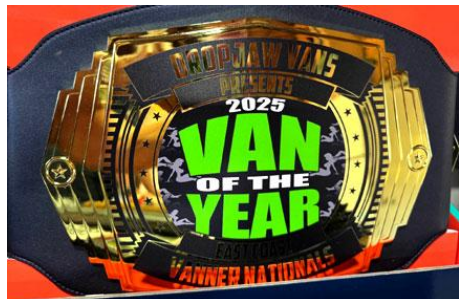
