Minutes of the June 11, 2011 meeting at Magnuson Hotel - Marina Cove Resort in St. Petersburg are as follows:

Linard called the meeting to order.

Minutes of the March 12, 2011 meeting were read and approved.

There were 9 clubs present and ONE Excused Absence (out of 12 clubs total) during roll call.

During Roll Call, Gnarly noted that Spaceman wanted to become active in vanning again. He wanted to have Grateful Sleds on the roster again. The group concluded that he could not have the club active unless he started attending the FVC meetings. Spookytooth

We decided that the one of the Townhouse rooms, #441, would be used for the Hospitality Room, so Christine booked it for us during the meeting.




