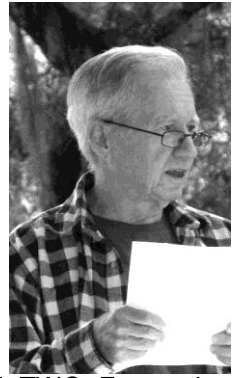
Minutes of the January 12, 2013 meeting at Doe Lake Campground, in the Ocala National Forest, are as follows:

Buffalo Bob called the meeting to order.

Minutes of the November 10, 2012 meeting were read and approved.

Bob called for a minute of silence in remembrance of Q's son AJ. Q has requested that folks quit sending him photos of AJ, as he isn't quite ready for that yet.

There were 10 clubs present (out of 14 clubs total) and TWO Excused Absences during roll call. Steve Capps volunteered to stop by and check on Spaceman to see the status of Grateful Sleds.



TREASURER'S REPORT:

Linard gave the Treasurer's report, and handed John the final payment for the huge deficit from the CofC 2012 meeting loss to a round of applause. Six Pack noted that it has been slightly less than one year and the FVC has paid off the whole loss. Buffalo Bob noted that the FVC owes John a lot, and, the fact that the FVC has pulled together to pay off the debt re-confirms that we are a FAMILY. Randy Connell, representing Vanners for Vanners gave Linard a \$100 check for that debt fund.

NEWSLETTER REPORT:

Gnarly noted that it was nice and easy for him to print a small newsletter this time, but, he would like to print a big newsletter next time. That requires the members to send in those pictures, or, links to where Gnarly can get the pictures, as well as articles. Mook noted that, currently, mailings for the newsletter are costing us \$20 an issue.

You don't have to be an officer to send in an article. And, it could be a camping recipe, hints on cleaning your van, etc. Deadline for inputs to the next issue of the newsletter is February 17.

OLD BUSINESS:

Chester noted that his December 28 New Years Eve party had the usual crowd and everyone had a good time.

Six Pack noted that 70 folks showed up for Broward's Christmas Party and a good time was had by all.

NEW BUSINESS:

Gnarly noted that, at Vanners for Vanners, some folks forgot that “dogs must be on a leash” means that the OTHER end of the leash must be attached to a human hand, tree, van bumper, etc. It doesn’t count if the dog is running loose dragging the leash on the ground behind him.

In thinking of another potential event location, Lorrie said she was going to check out all of the current conditions at River Forest. We used to host Vanners for Vanners at River Forest, near Deland. Randy Connell noted that, if you want to have an FVC meeting at River Forest, it isn’t free. The current costs to rent that Federal Camping Site is \$150 per day, plus tax. Or \$309 total for two days, from Friday 3 PM to Sunday at Noon. Buffalo Bob noted that having an FVC meeting in association with an event works out very well, financially.

VAN-IN UPDATES:

Vanners for Vanners Randy Connell thanked everyone who attended Vanners for Vanners this weekend. He also noted that the group has been putting on this event for 16 years straight and they need a break. So, Vanners for Vanners is taking 2014 off. We’ll be back in 2015, maybe with a slightly different date; maybe with a different location.

If any club or group wants to host something in 2014 at this location around this time frame, we’ll be glad to work with you on details and share our expertise in how we’ve put this on. However, the rules have changed regarding Federal Campgrounds. If you want to host an event here (or, at any Federal Campground), you have to check their schedule and book the campground NOW, and PAY THE FULL AMOUNT NOW. Bottom line is you need to have \$309 in hand to pay for the campground for 2 nights at the time you make the reservation.

Broward March 22 - 25, 2013. Sidewinder’s place in White Springs. Same as usual. Just be sure to watch your language. FVC meeting on Saturday

Foreplay May 3 – 5, 2013 – Beverly Beach. Magoo said everything’s on schedule. Will have the burgers & hot dogs stand. Will have a swap meet, Flea Market, Yard Sale. See the flier.

Red Eye Truckers June 7 – 9, 2013 – Rocking Red Eye Van Run – Floridian R.V. Resort - FVC meeting will be held on Saturday. \$15 pre-reg. You pay the campground directly. Camping costs run about \$36 for 2 nights. So, stay Friday night and Saturday night and total cost will be about \$51. Covered Dish Social, games, video entertainment on Friday. Pancake and Sausage breakfast on Saturday, as well as FVC meeting, games, toy van race, “Down South” picnic dinner, movies.

National Truck-In July 10 – 14, 2013 – Old Washington, Ohio. Six Pack is taking pre-reg's now. A motion by Judith that we put a full page ad in the NATS bible advertising our Keys eVant was carried by unanimous hand vote. Lou Oliver donated \$25 towards that ad. A motion by Joe Van that we also sponsor two \$25 ads (1 van show and 1 kids trophy) passed by a unanimous hand vote.

There was a suggestion that we could make mugs, etc. and sell them at the NATS. Lew & Judith said it would be a waste of time and money. Also, we don't have the manpower to do that, since most of us are volunteering to work at the NATS.

Junior & Glenda August 30, 2013 – September 2, 2013. FVC meeting on Saturday, August 31, 2013.

GSVR IX October 4 - 6, 2013 – Flaming Arrow Campground just south of Cherokee, NC. Great little event. Most of us want to do both, but some of us can't, because the date is 3 weeks ahead of the FVC event in the Florida Keys. Buffalo Bob noted that he already pre-registered for the Keys in August so he won't be hunting for cash to go to GSVR IX in October. That spreads the cost out a little, since both events are in October.

FVC October 25 - 27, 2013 – FVC's 40th Anniversary Truck-In - Sunshine Key Campground, mile marker 39, U.S. 1 in the Florida Keys. Spookytooth noted that he got with Brenda, at the campground, and, on the 14th of December the contract was signed. He noted that THIS IS AN FVC-SPONSORED EVENT. We need FVC members to support it. This will be the 30th year since Broward and Liquordale brought the Keys eVant back to life. Judith noted that this is the 40th anniversary of the FVC. We're going to have 40th birthday party, and we will have the "Ugly Prom Dress" contest.

Randy Connell presented Buffalo Bob and Carol with Vanners for Vanners embroidered aprons. They have been extremely dedicated and supportive of the event for many years.

Buffalo Bob noted that we have a link on the home page of our website and info in our newsletter regarding vanning on-line. So why not keep up with vanning events, and get the latest vanning info right on your PC?

Cari made a motion to adjourn and the meeting was concluded.

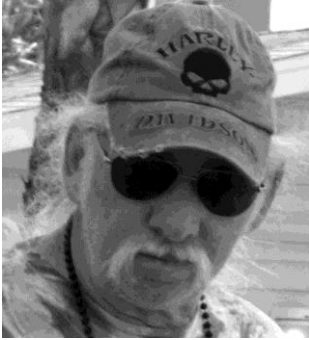

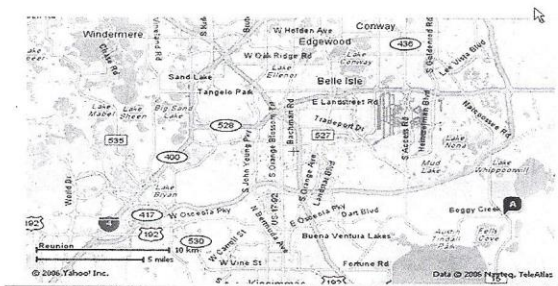

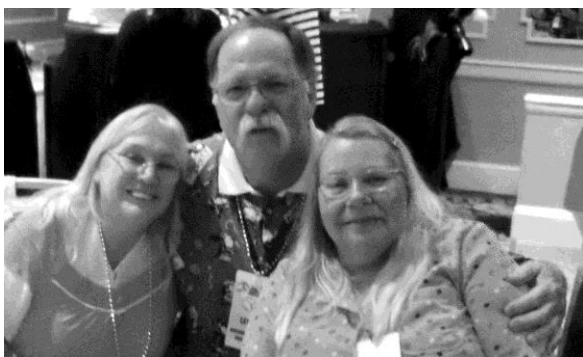
The FVC at the 2013 council of councils

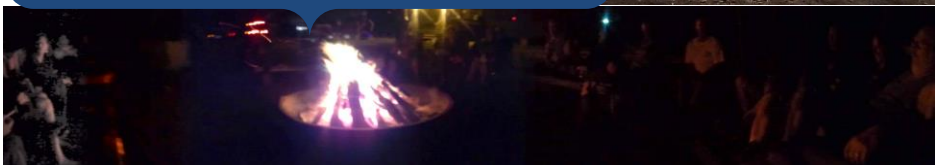
