Minutes of the November 15, 2014 meeting at the Zephyrhills Auto Auction and Vanarama in Pasco County are as follows:


Rich called the meeting to order.

NEW BUSINESS:

Lew noted that this Carlisle Auto Show event will be held on November 12 - 15 at Sun 'n Fun next year. Sun 'n Fun is adjacent to the Lakeland - Linder regional airport (KLAL) in Lakeland, FL.



Mark Sydney, of Summit Racing Equipment, gave the group a short talk about the Atlanta Motorama (atlantamotorama.com) to be held at the Atlanta Motor Speedway April 18-19, 2015. The Atlanta Motor Speedway is a NASCAR track, located about 80 miles South of Atlanta. There are a lot of activities, such as lawn mower races, Pinstriper Panel Jam, Tear Down and Rebuild Engine contest, Salon Cars, like an old Duesenberg, and more. Lots of cash and prizes.

Car clubs get special consideration. FVC would classify as a car club. We would have to register all together. They don't accept club entries coming in one at a time. Each club has a designated area, gets preferred parking and get awards, like trophies we might want to give out. For example, 5-9 cars pre-registered will receive 2 awards. Clubs must have 5 or more cars pre-registered. \$35 registration for Saturday through Sunday. Registrants will have an opportunity to drive around the NASCAR track.

VAN-IN UPDATES:

- Council of Councils February 12 14, 2015 Hosted by Colorado Van Council Denver, Colorado. 19 rooms left. They will attempt to have a van show, weather permitting. It does snow in Denver in February.
- Vanners for Vanners February 20 22, 2015 River Forest Group Camping Site in the Ocala National Forest, near Deland. Randy Connell told the group that the event has been cancelled. He said that there had been a serious lack of interest as indicated by the fact that, as of this meeting, there had been no pre-registrations at all. In the past there was enough money to cover getting the food in advance and the other things that have to be paid for "up front" but not now. He noted that this has been a "good run" for 16 years, but it's time to shut the event down. He said that he would be glad to assist anyone, or any group, that wanted to put on a similar event at that time of the year.

At this point, a motion by Gnarly (seconded by Leslie) that the FVC take over and put on an event in that time frame was passed, to a round of applause, by a unanimous hand vote. Randy C. will get the necessary information to Linard for FVC to take over the campground for the February weekend. Then, Linard will reimburse Randy for the deposit on the campground and FVC will be hosting the event. It is anticipated that the event will be modified to be a potluck event, somewhat similar to the November FVC meeting.

ForePlay May 1 - 3, 2015 – Beverly Beach Camptown, Flagler Beach, FL - Magoo said everything is on schedule. No flier is available at this time.

This is a 1999 Chevy Astro better known as "Slammin Astro".



The van began its days as a V6 passenger van and now the van has a 1998 LS1 engine paired with the 4L60e automatic transmission. All the power goes to a custom 4 link Ford 9" rear with 3.56 gearing. The van has an air ride suspension with front and rear Firestone bags, two Viair compressors and three 5 gallon air tanks. Each wheel has its own control valve and is controlled by a Dakota air management system.

The van's 100"x48" canvas top opens up nice and wide for that convertible car feel and gives a nice view of the night sky at the vannins. The interior of the van was gutted, swivel seats were installed up front, and laminate wood flooring was installed along with a sofa bed in the rear. The gray interior is now a mix of black and plaid materials with future changes in store. The audio system is nothing too special. There is a 7" touch screen DVD head unit with a 27" rear television and a few speakers here and there. Everything in the van is powered by a pair of batteries that were relocated just under the wood flooring behind the passenger's seat.

Slammin Astro is a very interesting ride that makes getting to the vannins as much an adventure as the vannins themselves. Future plans include a permanent rear bed with much more storage available underneath as well as some interior enhancements to give it a more custom look on the inside to match the craziness outside. As with all our vans. They are never really "finished"
