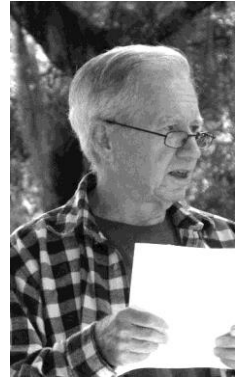
Minutes of the September 5, 2015 meeting at Clark Family Campground in Orange City are as follows:

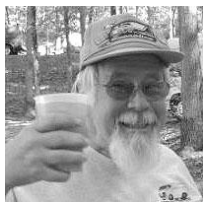
