NEW BUSINESS:

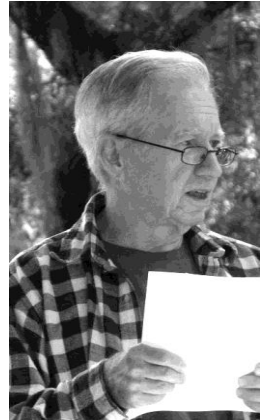
Judith noted that we have one new FVC member who joined up today.
