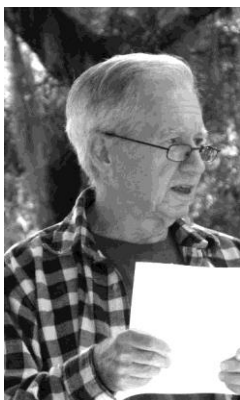

CFV member, Gary Miller, helped Lew build cabinets and a u-shaped sitting area which could easily be made into a bed. I wood burned a design into the cabinets and table. Then, stained and clear coated it. Larry Marlett helped Lew put in a sun roof. We also installed two gull wing doors. Lew got the show bug and named our van "Nutin Fancy" we won many trophies, including a Nationals trophy. We traveled all over the country with two kids in the back. Our first Nationals was the 11th in 1983. Since then, we have attended almost every Nationals. Over the years, we helped put on many events. Lew chaired several Florida eVANTs. Among them was Christmas in July, one of the Bikini State eVANTs put on by CFV, also The Beach Party by Southern Coaches. We both were committee heads for the Nationals hosted by the Nats Board. This year our dream of bringing the Nationals to Florida finally became a reality. Lew was Chairman and I was secretary of the 44th Van Nationals in Florida. He also was President. I was the Newsletter editor for CFV back when cut and paste meant I typed an article on a manual typewriter. Then, cut it out with scissors and glued it where it needed to be in the newsletter. I distributed several hundred newsletters throughout Florida and the USA. Years later, I took over the FVC Newsletter when home computers became the thing. We raised two kids vanning to every state in the continental USA, Canada and England. Eight vans later, we are retired and our grandkids travel in back of a van. We own a 2006 white Econoline 350, diesel Van, which pulls our airstream camper to visit all our vanning friends. Maybe we will be at an eVANT near you sometime soon! Keep Vanning!

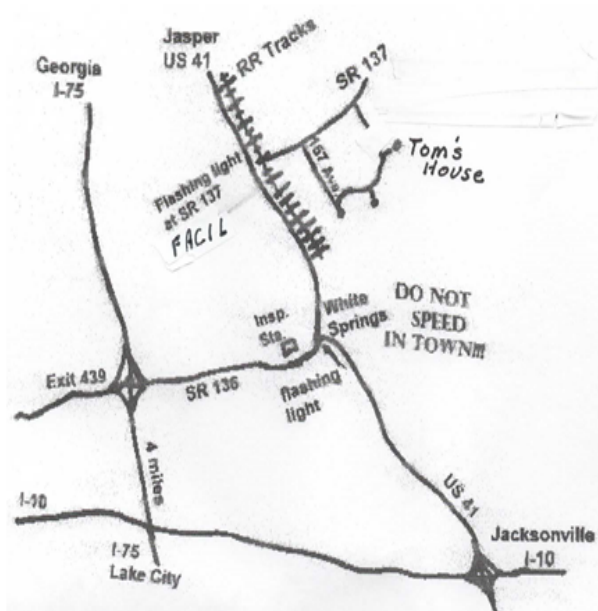
