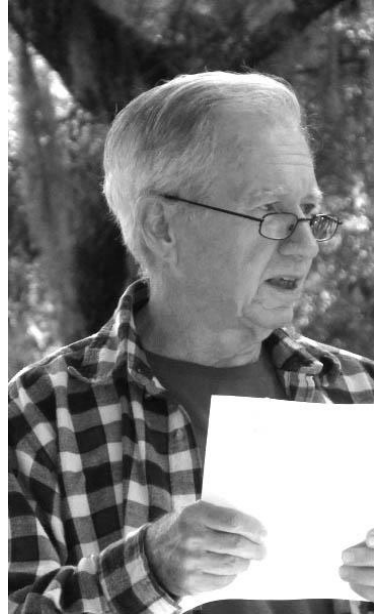
FLORIDA VAN COUNCIL

Minutes of the June 17, 2017 meeting at Luna Sands Resort (formerly Clark Family Campground) in Orange City are as follows:

Plans are to charge \$65 per van for this 3-day weekend and \$80 per camper. It was also mentioned that we should charge a "day" rate of \$10 for those who aren't able to spend the whole weekend, but just want to come for the FVC meeting.

A motion by Cari (seconded by Steve Capps) that the FVC host the Labor Day event, as presented, was carried by a unanimous hand vote. Leslie requested that Deb bring the Vanners Feud game to the event.

Cari was presented with a retirement cake and bag from the FVC members.

SpookyTooth noted that we have a prospective new FVC member; Andrew, known as "Boo". We have seen him at the 44th NATS and at Hi-Way Vanners event in April.

It was noted that Luna Sands Resort is going private. So, this will be the last FVC meeting and event at this location.

We should all keep "Catfish" and Penny, from the Southeast Van Council, in our prayers. He had a stroke yesterday and is in the hospital in Daytona.

SpookyTooth noted that Gilligan of Ft. Liquordale passed away last week.

Cari made a motion to adjourn and the meeting was concluded.

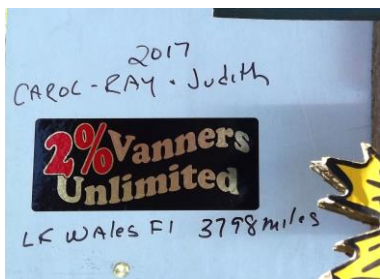


2017 Van Nationals
