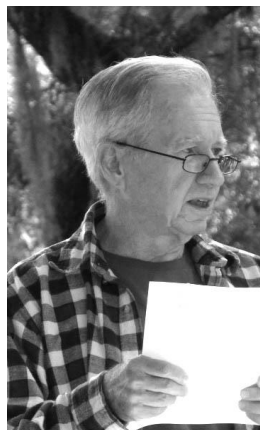
Minutes of the November 12, 2016 meeting at Carlisle Vanarama at Sun 'n Fun in Lakeland are as follows:
