#### FLORIDA VAN COUNCIL

Minutes of the January 14, 2017 meeting at River Forest Group Camping area near Deland are as follows:

SpookyTooth called the meeting to order. He noted that, if you want to contact him, call his cell phone number, send an e-mail, or use snail mail. He isn't on social media and has no intention of getting on social media.

Minutes of the November 12, 2016 meeting were read and approved with 2 corrections. Price for Hi-Way Vanners event in April was listed as \$5 per van for the weekend. It should have been listed as \$60 per van for the weekend. The commemorative license plates for Carlisle Vanarama were created by Ed Beard, Jr. The wording didn't specifically say that Carlisle created the plates, but the wording implied that they did.

There were 10 clubs present and NO Excused Absences (out of 14 active clubs total) during roll call.

#### TREASURER'S REPORT:

Leslie gave the Treasurer's report.

#### **NEWSLETTER REPORT:**

Gnarly gave the newsletter report and noted that deadline for inputs to the next issue of the Newsletter is mid-February. That way, he will be able to include reports from the 2017 Council of Councils (CofC) meeting. He noted that you should send him an e-mail if you no longer want to receive paper inputs of the newsletter. He will send you the digital copy only and that will save on printing and mailing costs. #### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Lew noted that you must put "Show February" when you register for the Carlisle Auto Show in February in order to get the 20% discount.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Lew noted that the first annual Christmas Party and Fund Raiser to benefit the Museum of Vanning was a big success. The second annual event is planned for the second weekend in December 2017.

Leslie noted that Bigfoot Paul has advanced cancer and is not expected to last long. She has the address if you wish to send cards, etc.

Joe Van noted that there seems to be a misconception about the Halloween Party he has been having at his place for the past few years. It is NOT a van event. It is a party at his house for those who either can't afford to attend the Keys eVant or can't schedule the time off from work.

There seems to be a misconception on social media because some vanners have referred to it as a "Keys Party North", implying that this party is competing with the event at Sunshine Key put on by the FVC. This is NOT the case. Joe attended the FVC event for well over a dozen years and, if he could still make that event, he would, but circumstances currently prevent that from happening. So, he and his friends have a Halloween party at his place. Vanners are also welcome if they want to come.

Joe said that he has seen no proof that any vanner who could attend the FVC event picked his party instead, which would be undercutting the FVC event.

Gnarly and Cari noted that the folks using social media should quit referring to Joe & Celia's Halloween party as "Keys Party North" as that is misleading and inaccurate. That prompted SpookyTooth to say "That's why I don't do any of that social media stuff!"

#### **VAN-IN PROPOSALS:**

Florida Van Council October 27 - 29, 2017 - A motion by Lew Skoko (seconded by Cari) that the FVC sponsor the annual Halloween event at Sunshine Key and that it be an FVC-sanctioned event was carried by a unanimous hand vote. SpookyTooth noted that Brenda (from the campground) told him that there was an RV group that wanted our usual dates and spots, but she would hold the spots for us if we wanted that. Scribe John reminded the group that FVC-sanctioned means that, if we have a van show, it must be done according to the FVC van judging rules. Also, the FVC officers get in free at all FVC-sanctioned events. That provision in the by-laws never got changed, but it has pretty much been ignored by all the FVC officers for the last 10 or 15 years.

We need to encourage pre-reg as that really helps the host club or council. He was glad to see that there is a \$15 difference between pre-reg and gate entry at Hi-Way Vanners event. Lew suggested that it might be a good idea to have 2 different lines for food. Pre-reg gets in the food line first.

Mark noted that not everyone in Florida is retired. If you pre-reg and then can't go because of work, that money is just gone. Gnarly noted that he still works for a living and if he can't go because of work, that's just his support for the event. Judith commented "Bottom line is, if you can pre-reg; DO IT!"

#### 2017 FVC MEETING SCHEDULE:

HEARTH stands for "Homeless Education Advocates Restoring The Hope". It is a project of the Polk County School System that has identified over 2100 of their students in a homeless situation so far this school year. They have been able to help a student with an orthodontic expense, provide many shoe vouchers and help homeless kids with other expenses. Judith said, "If you played the games, then you supported this event and helped some homeless students."

Judith suggested, at the last meeting, that the FVC consider making a bid to host the 2019 Council of Councils meeting. All the members attending this meeting rejected that and proposed, instead, that we consider making a bid to host the 2020 Council of Councils meeting. Cari noted that we should have no problem using Cocoa Beach again, but we still have the problem of transportation from Orlando International Airport to Cocoa Beach for those who fly in to the event. There's just no good way to fly directly in to Cocoa Beach.
